**Congresswoman Millender-McDonald to Announce New Goods

Washington, DC - Congresswoman Millender-McDonald and Congressman Diaz-Balart have joined forces to create the Goods Movement Caucus, a bi-partisan caucus to address issues and concerns related to the reauthorization of TEA-21 and the dual roles that business and the mobilization of people play within the country's transportation infrastructure and its effect on our national and local economies.

The Goods Movement Caucus will also focus on issues related to goods movement such as economic development, combating congesting in our communities, developing public/private partnership, and ensuring that goods movement is safe and secure.
