Robert C. Dynes is marking his first year as the 18th president of the University of California. President Dynes, a physicist and an expert on semiconductors and superconductors, assumed his responsibilities as president in October 2003. From 1996 until then, he had served as chancellor of UC's San Diego campus. Dynes came to UC San Diego in 1991 after a 22-year career at AT&T Bell Laboratories, where he served as department head of semiconductor and material physics research and director of chemical physics research.
